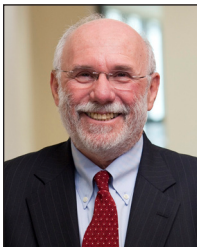

Dr. Levine has been Director of the Center for Vaccine Development since its inception in 1974. He is clinically trained in pediatrics and pediatric infectious diseases, as well as in tropical public health and epidemiology. Dr. Levine's research has focused on infectious diseases that afflict infants, children and adults in developing countries, including cholera, typhoid and paratyphoid fevers, Shigella dysentery, Escherichia coli diarrhea, and invasive infections (e.g., sepsis, meningitis) caused by Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib), Streptococcus pneumoniae and non-typhoidal Salmonella (NTS), among other pathogens.
